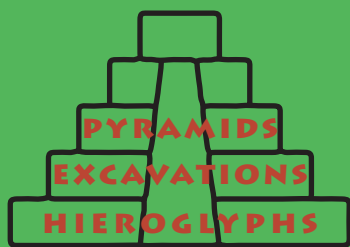

When: June 22-26, 2020

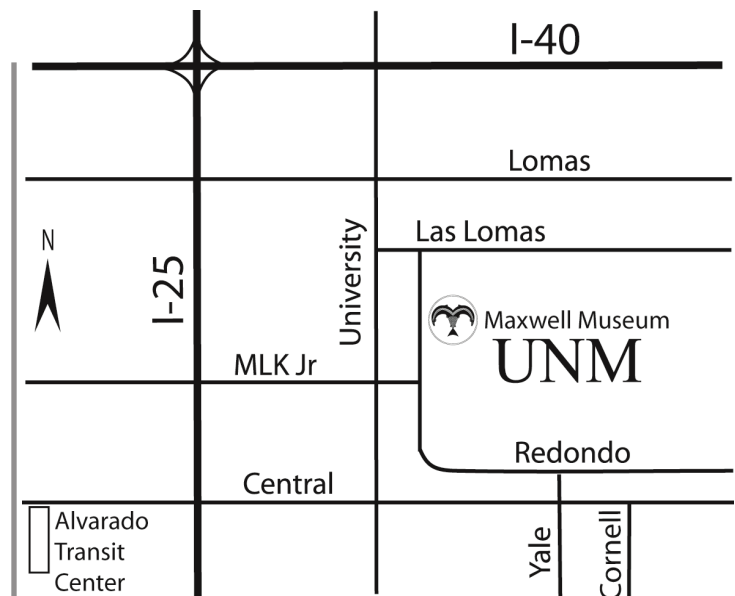
Time: 9:00 am – 5:00 pm
