Museum of Anthropology.



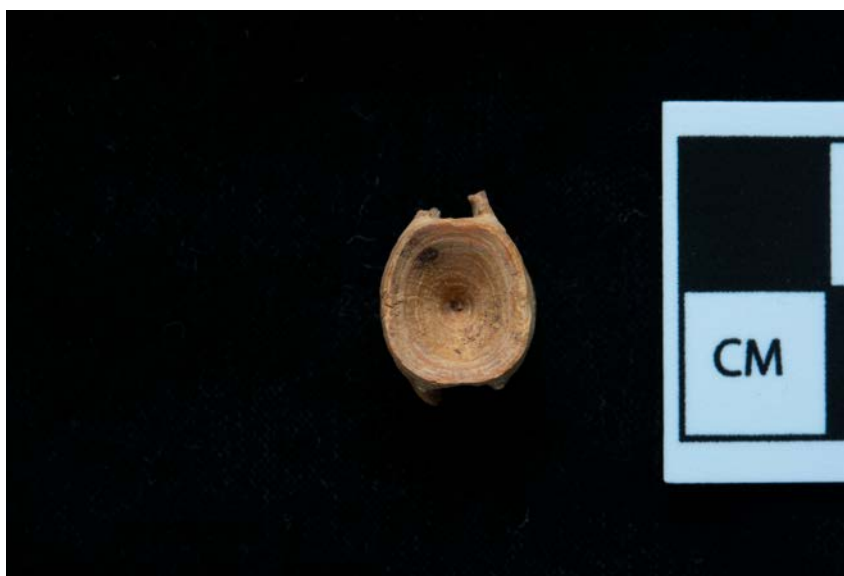
